Dear Attorney General Dann,

On behalf of the members of the Ohio Christian Alliance and all citizens of the Christian faith across the State of Ohio, I write to express our great disappointment and alarm at recent comments attributed to you in a story in the Dayton Daily News.

We are outraged that you, the Attorney General of the State of Ohio, would make a bigoted, disparaging remark in reference to Jesus Christ in an official communiqué on Good Friday of this year with your communications director, Leo Jennings III, in an official email dated April 6, 2007. As I trust you are aware, this email was referenced in the most recent Sunday edition of the Dayton Daily News in an article by Laura Bishoff. Consequently, the Ohio Christian Alliance has received a number of emails and phone calls complaining about your comments and calling for a response to your offensive remarks.

My fellow citizens and I are shocked and appalled that you, as an elected official, would make such a bigoted, disparaging remark in regard to Jesus Christ, our Savior and the leader of the Christian faith on one of the most holy days of the Christian calendar. That such an intolerant comment would be made by Ohio's Attorney General, whose duty it is to defend the rights of all Ohioans, only adds to our distress.

We will not tolerate such insensitivity from our elected officials. Therefore, we request an apology from you and a guarantee that people of faith will not be subjected to bigoted remarks by you in the future. It is our hope that you will address this in an appropriate manner.
