Ohio Christian Alliance Urges a NO vote on Issue 3. Vote NO Casinos.

- Issue 3 will allow casinos to be open 24-hours a day, seven days a week, and it does not limit the number of table games that each casino could operate.
- Issue 3 will require each casino to pay a tax of only 33% on its gross casino revenues. In other states there are much higher taxes. The legislature may not increase this tax.
- Issue 3 could drive up bankruptcy and foreclosure rates in Ohio as has happened in other states where casinos have been legalized.
- Issue 3 will create new gambling addicts, ruining lives and families.
- These four casinos will hurt honest business in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, and Toledo.
- Casinos cost jobs, ruin lives and destroy families.

Ballot Issues Continued (Summary of Issues 1&2)

ISSUE 1: This proposed amendment would authorize the state to issue up to two hundredmillion dollars (\$200,000,000) of bonds to provide compensation to Ohio veterans of thePersian Gulf, Afghanistan, and Iraq conflicts, and to pay for the administration of thePersian Gulf, Afghanistan, and Iraq Conflicts Compensation Bond Retirement Fund and the Persian Gulf, Afghanistan, and Iraq Conflicts Compensation Fund.

ISSUE 2: Amended Substitute Senate Joint Resolution Number 6 (SJR 6) would require the state to create the Livestock Care Standards Board to prescribe standards for animal care and well-being that endeavor to maintain food safety, encourage locally grown and raised food, and protect Ohio farms and families.
