RELIGIOUS EXPRESSION AND MORALITY

Display of Ten Commandments on public property

Supports

TAXES AND SPENDING

Requiring voter approval for state tax increases

Supports

EDUCATION AND PARENTING

Legislation to require instruction in the U.S. Constitution, the Bill of Rights, the Ohio Constitution, the Northwest Ordinance, and other foundational documents as part of schools' American Government and American History curriculums

Supports

Legislation that allows for intelligent design to be taught alongside evolution in public schools

Supports

CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND THE 2nd AMENDMENT

Mandatory prison terms for persons convicted of violent crimes, such as rape and armed robbery

Supports

State registration of firearms and licensing of gun owners

Opposes

Requiring handguns to be sold with trigger locks

ABORTION AND EUTHANASIA

Prohibiting abortion except in cases where the life of the mother is endangered

JOBS AND EMPLOYMENT

Legislation to prohibit the use of compulsory union dues and fees for political causes and candidates opposed by union members
